SEWING TIPS

- Work slowly and be patient
- Make sure your fabric is not twisted or folded\
- Stitch close together so your stuffing doesn't fall out.
- Pull each stitch slowly and watch for knots and twisted string
- Pull stitches taut but not tight. No gaping thread. No puckered fabric.
- Tie a knot and get new thread with 5in left.

It's easier to sew it right the first time than it is to un-sew and re-sew. Pay attention and take your time.

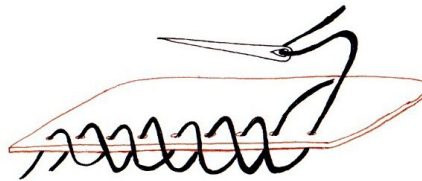
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WHIP STITCHES

Join fabric together by wrapping the stitch around the seam from front to back

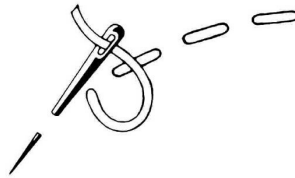


practice a whip stitch



RUNNING STITCHES

Join fabric together by stitching in the middle of the fabric. The needle moves over-under-over-under.



practice a running stitch



- FOLLOW THE PATH OF THE LINE
- PUNCH A HOLE AT EACH DOT
